

Memorandum of Understanding

Between

Kosovo Legal Profession Program (KLP)

And

Kosovo Chamber of Advocates (KCA)

Article 1 Objective

Objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is establishment of cooperation between KLP and KCA in undertaking joint efforts for further development and improvement of the Legal Profession in Kosovo, under the scope of the activities defined with the Kosovo Legal Profession Program.

Article 2 Obligations of the KLP

- 2.1** KLP is obliged to support the KCA in promoting legal excellence of its members as well as to advance the services provided under the Mandatory Continuous Legal Education.
- 2.2** KLP is obliged to support KCA in attracting membership from underrepresented groups, including women and minorities, as well as to strengthen regional branches of the KCA in provision of services to their members.
- 2.3** KLP further undertakes to make available for the KCA the expertise of its *pro bono* training experts, pursuant to the established needs of the KCA in its program for Mandatory Continuous Legal Education of advocates.

Article 3
Obligations of the KCA

KCA recognizes and accepts KLP as its partner in further development and improvement of the Legal Profession in Kosovo and undertakes to support joint initiatives under the work plan of the Kosovo Legal Profession Program.

Article 4
Duration of the memorandum

- 4.1 This MoU is signed for a period of one year, with possibility of extension.
- 4.2 In case none of the parties announces termination of the present MoU one month before its expiry, the MoU is deemed to be automatically extended.
- 4.3 Maximum duration of the MoU is three years (2012 – 2014).

Article 5
Entry into force

The present Memorandum enters into force on the date of its signature by the parties.

In full agreement, parties sign this Memorandum of Understanding on 24^h of February 2012.
